1. Introduction

This Cookies Policy explains how Coastline Futures Ltd uses cookies and similar technologies when you visit our website.

Cookies are small text files placed on your device that help websites function effectively, improve user experience and provide information about how visitors use the site.

This policy should be read alongside our Privacy Policy, which explains how we collect, use and protect personal information.

2. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small files stored on your computer, tablet or mobile device when you visit a website.

They help websites to:

- Remember your preferences and settings
- Improve website functionality
- Measure website performance
- Understand how visitors interact with the website
- Enhance the user experience

Cookies do not usually identify you personally, but they may be linked to information you voluntarily provide.

3. Types of Cookies We Use

Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the operation of our website and cannot be switched off.

They may be used to:

- Remember cookie preferences
- Enable website security features
- Support contact and enquiry forms
- Ensure the website functions correctly

Without these cookies, parts of the website may not work properly.

Analytics and Performance Cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors use our website so we can improve the information and services we provide.

They may collect information such as:

- Number of visitors
- Pages visited
- Time spent on pages
- Navigation patterns
- Website performance and errors

Where possible, this information is collected anonymously.

Functional Cookies

These cookies allow the website to provide enhanced functionality and personalised features.

Examples include:

- Embedded videos
- Social media content
- Remembering user preferences
- Accessibility settings

If you disable these cookies, some features of the website may not function as intended.

4. Third-Party Cookies

Some cookies may be placed by trusted third-party services that appear on our website.

Examples may include:

- Google Analytics
- YouTube
- Facebook

- LinkedIn
- Instagram

These organisations have their own privacy and cookies policies, and we encourage users to review them for further information.

5. Managing Cookies

When you first visit our website, you may be asked to accept or manage your cookie preferences.

You can also control cookies through your web browser settings.

Most browsers allow you to:

- View cookies stored on your device
- Delete cookies
- Block cookies entirely
- Control cookies for individual websites
